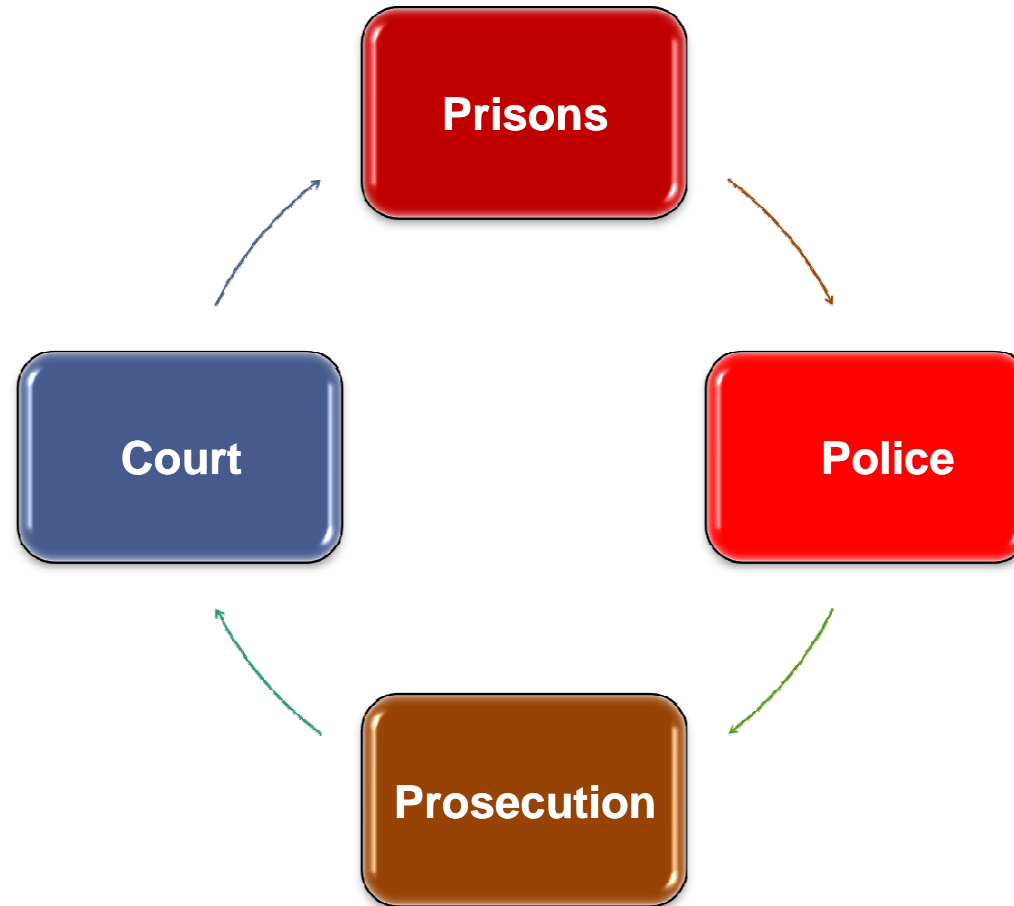

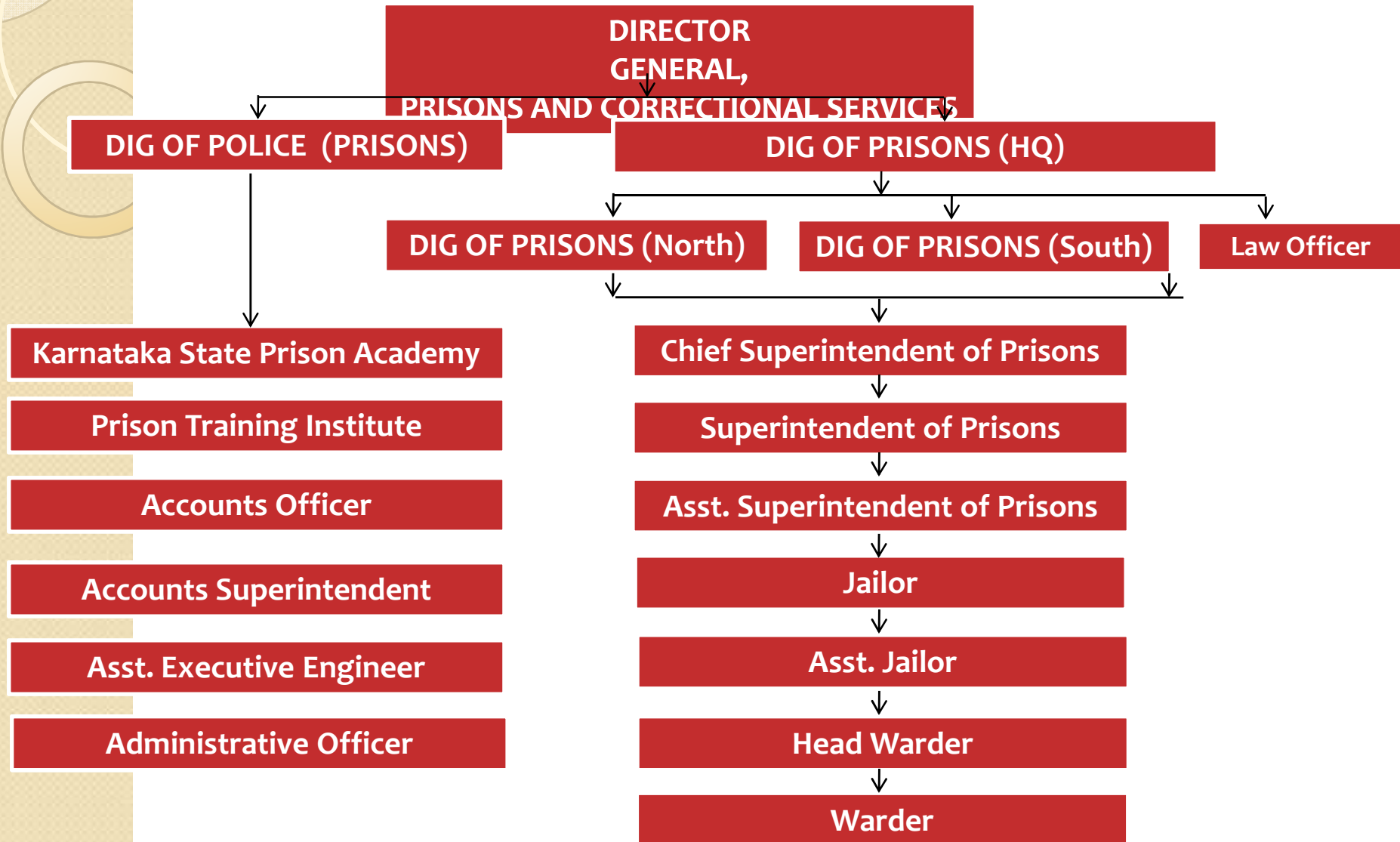

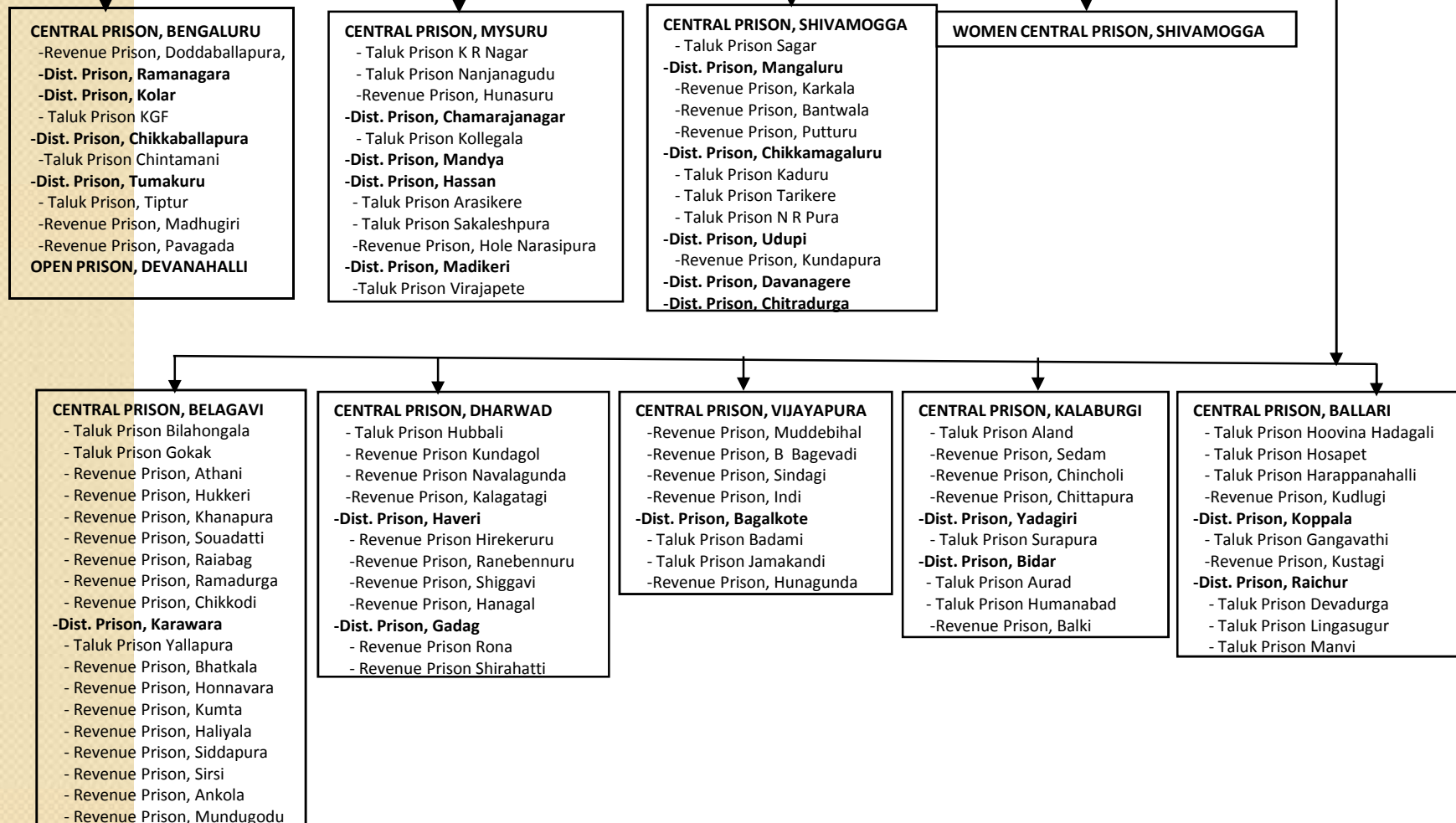

PPP in prisons

- BPO training in MoU with **Mindtree Ltd** at Central Prison, Bengaluru
- Wheel Chair Refurbishing unit in MoU with **ProVision Asia**, an NGO.
- Agarbatti Packaging MoU with **M/s. Ranga Rao and sons**, Mysore.

Prison Call system :

- Advanced mode of Biometric based prison call systems have been installed in
 - all 9 Central Prisons and
 - one District Prison, Mangalore
 - It is proposed to install in all District Prisons
 - There is a proposal to increase number of booths in Prisons



Open Prison

- More Stress is given to Agricultural and horticultural activities
- Facility of Drip irrigation and required amenities
- Concept of Israel Agriculture and Horticultural will be adopted shortly at Open Prison.

PAROLE

- Liberal policy is being followed
- Parole Rules have been simplified
- Security deposit amount has been revised from Rs 6000/- to Rs 1000/-

Premature Release

- 219 life convicted prisoners released prematurely for their good conduct
 - 07.03.2018 -92 life convicts,
 - 09.09.2018 -79 life convicts
 - and 5.10.2018 -48 short term convicts
- Proposal for new guidelines for premature release is under active consideration.



Steam cooking units

- Steam cooking units are available at all Central Prisons and District Prisons
- Inmates are engaged in modern technique in cooking system.
- It is one of the positive impact on inmates

Diet

- Revised diet scale (2014-15) has been implemented from 2015 providing nutritious food - quality and quantity has been enhanced
- Varieties in breakfast
- Region based food
 - **Egg once a week**
 - **Fish for coastal region**
 - **Chicken in some districts**
- Nutritious Diet scale fixed for children (of 0-6months, 6-1 year , 2-3 and 3-6 years of age) as per Supreme Court guidelines
- Separate Food /Diet Scale is fixed for Pregnant and lactating women prisoners as per Supreme Court guidelines

Manual Revision

- Karnataka Prison Manual 1978 has been revised and redrafted incorporating several provisions of Model Prison Manual.

Theatre Art Therapy

- Theatre Art has been adopted as one of the reformative measure to reform inmates to become good citizens
- Inmates are trained in Theatre Art. Encouraged to stage various play on prestigious stages
- Inmates staged play across various stages of Karnataka, National Drama Festival at Mysuru
- Recently troupe of inmates from Central Prison, Mysuru staged two play's at Mysuru Association Auditorium , Matunga Road, Mumbai

Prison Orchestra

- Troupe of inmates are trained in handling musical instruments and singing.
- Inmates of Central Prison, Mysuru and Bengaluru are allowed to present Musical Orchestra at various Government functions.
- Instrumental Musicians of Central Prison, Bengaluru have been engaged in Music Therapy process for Mentally ill prisoners (**Sahayana Programme**)

Prison Panchayat

- Prison Panchayat are running in all Central and District Prisons.
- Panchs are selected among the inmates.
- Six months term in case of Central Prisons and Three months for District Prisons.
- Panchs supervise the Kitchen, Hygiene and Diet



Information KIOSK

- Information Kiosks have been installed in all Central Prisons and District Prisons
- System will provide data pertaining to inmates viz., Appeal Status, Court hearing, Case Status
- Inmates are trained and engaged in this system to assist other inmates to access the facility



Canteen facility

- Facility is existing in all Central and District Prisons
- They run on No Profit and No loss basis
- Tea, Coffee, eatables, Stationery, soaps, tooth paste are sold in canteen in exchange of of coupons

- Wages have been revised
- - 4 Categories
 - Highly Skilled
 - Skilled
 - Semi Skilled
 - Unskilled

- Inmates are also trained in this aspect to spread awareness among inmates



Health Check up and awareness

- Programmes are held in coordination with
 - Government Hospital / District Hospital
 - Regional Medical Colleges / Hospitals
 - Prominent NGO are rendering their hands
 - An MoU with KSAPS, NACO is in force for creating awareness for detection and prevention of illness
 - An MoU with Bengaluru Medical Centre for attending emergencies

- Cash reward facility has been introduced
- To enthuse the prison officers and staff
- To deliver best performance and achievements in regular duties

PRISON DEVELOPMENT BOARD

- Proposed to establish Prison Development Board under the chairmanship of Director General/ Additional Director General of Police and Inspector General of Prisons
 - to examine the living conditions of prisoners in all prisons
 - and to provide sufficient accommodation with specific reference to basic needs and
 - Proper correctional programmes,
 - improvement to prison building and quarters,
 - expanding of industrial activities in prisons ,
formulation modrenisation of prison plans.
